Why is Kiribati developing a telecommunications sector?

The ICT sector in Kiribati requires new investment for services to expand. The project aims to strengthen the legal, regulatory and institutional environment to stimulate such investment, and thereby enabling transition to a market-driven telecommunications sector. The project also seeks to facilitate improved connectivity for the Outer Islands.

Does Kiribati have a media industry?

Kiribati's local media industry has faced diminished funding, with the state-owned Broadcasting and Publications Authority (BPA) relying on minimal government funding and advertising revenue to stay afloat. Further, BPA's Radio Kiribati has limited working equipment, which has led to periodic disruptions to transmission.

Why is Radio Kiribati not working?

Is Kiribati preparing a new communications bill for market liberalization?


