What is solar power in South Africa?

Solar power in South Africa includes photovoltaics (PV) as well as concentrated solar power (CSP). As of July 2024, South Africa had 2,287 MW of installed utility-scale PV solar power capacity in its grid, in addition to 5,791 MW of rooftop solar and 500 MW of CSP. Installed capacity is expected to reach 8,400 MW by 2030.

How many South African homes have solar power?

Less than 10% of South African homes have installed solar power. Natrass/Getty Images South Africa is making efforts to increase the use of solar photovoltaic energy. But it's happening at a very slow pace.

How much does a solar PV system cost in South Africa?

For a typical home setup in SA (6 kWh solar PV system with 6 solar panels at 550W each), the cost of a solar PV system in South Africa is R110,000 on average. This includes everything (solar panels, inverters, mounting systems, and other necessary components). For larger or more complex installations (for a business), costs can go over R450,000.

Can solar panels save you money in South Africa?

Savings from solar panels for home use in South Africa depend on your energy usage, system size, and location. A 5kW system can reduce your electricity bill by 6,000 to 8,000 kWh annually, saving you around R19,800 to R26,400 per year. Higher usage and rising tariffs can increase your total savings even more.

Should solar panels be subsidised in South Africa?

Solar panels should be sold with motion sensors, floodlights and fasteners to prevent theft, and these security features should be subsidised by the government. Only 5% of South Africa's energy comes from solar power while 85% is generated from coal. Loans, more subsidies and security for rooftop solar panels need to be put in place.
