Where is Namibia's wind farm located?

The energy generated at this wind farm will be sold to NamPower, the national electricity parastatal company of Namibia, under a 25-year power purchase agreement (PPA). The power station is on the Atlantic coast, approximately 16 kilometres (9.9 mi) south of the town of Luderitz, in the Karas Region of Namibia.

Does Namibia have a 50 MW Luderitz wind IPP power project?

The Namibian Power Corporation (NamPower), Namibia's national power utility that operates under the Southern Africa country's Ministry of Mines and Energy, has launched a market-sounding exercise for the proposed 50 MW Luderitz Wind IPP Power Project.

Who owns NamPower wind farm?

NamPower, the Namibian public electricity utility company signed a 25-year power purchase agreement to purchase the entire power output of this wind farm. The table below illustrates the shareholding in the ad hoc company Cerim Luderitz Energy formed to own, build, finance, operate and maintain this power station.

Does Namibia use wind energy for electricity generation?

The Cerim Luderitz Wind Power Station, is a 50 MW (67,000 hp) power plant that is being developed in Namibia. The power station is under development and is owned by Cerim Luderitz Energy, a joint venture company owned by (a) China Energy Engineering Corporation (CEEC) and (b) Rimiini Investments, a Namibian company.
