The Kingdom aims to generate 50% of its electricity from renewable sources by the end of the decade, with solar energy leading the charge.

Is there a solar PV project in Saudi Arabia?

There is a substantial PV installation project in the Makkah province,which is expected to have a capacity of 2600 MW. This initiative is being progressively developed under the guidance of the Saudi Ministry of Energy. Fig. 3 presents a summary of the current status of solar PV projects in Saudi Arabia [36,37]. Will Saudi Arabia be able to produce 40 gigawatts of solar energy?

The ambitious target of Saudi Arabia's National Renewable Energy Program sees the Kingdom aiming for a solar energy capacity of 40 gigawatts by 2030,promising significant opportunities for the market in the years to come.

Is Saudi Arabia a good source of solar energy?

Clean energy secured a 44 MW solar facility for a desalination project in August 2022,and a joint venture planned a 12.5 MW hybrid solar farm at King Abdullah Economic City . Solar PV is Saudi Arabia's leading RE source,benefiting from abundant solar irradiation and the highest solar electricity generation capacity in the region .

What are the current conditions of solar plant projects in Saudi Arabia?

Present conditions of solar plant projects in Saudi Arabia . The Gulf states achieved 146 GW installed power capacity by 2020, with renewables at 3.27 GW. Solar PV dominates at 71 %, followed by CSP, biomass, and wind. UAE leads in adoption at 68 %, Saudi Arabia at 16 %, and Kuwait, as shown in Fig. 4.
