We're talking about a hub where Africa's renewable energy future is being shaped. Located in Lomé, Togo's coastal capital, this facility is like the Swiss Army knife of energy solutions.

The Adakope Solar Power Station is a planned 390 MW (520,000 hp) solar power plant in Togo, with 200 MWh (720 GJ), attached battery energy storage. The power station is in the development stage, under concessional terms by the company Arise Integrated Industrial Platforms (Arise IIP), a subsidiary of the Africa Finance Corporation (AFC), in partnership with the Government of Togo. As of July 2021 a qualified EPC company was being sought to construct the power station, either...
